Parents and Students must make their own travel arrangements and meet at the Camp. Look for me on arrival. I will not be able to pick up your chalet keys until 4.00 pm...so if you arrive earlier...you can just wander around the camp and make full use of the facilities. If you arrive LATER than 4.00 pm, ring my Mobile and I will tell you where I am and you can pick up your keys from me.

What should I bring with me?

- Tea Towels
- Towels
- Toiletries
- Washing up utensils
- Personal Effects

Cooking items, crockery, cutlery and Bed Linen are provided in all Self-Catering accommodation.

- **Don't Forget...**
Remember to pack your swimming things close to the top, as you can start your holiday as soon as you arrive on the Park, you don't need to have your keys to use the facilities!
- Students must bring their ball for training sessions.
- NO Celtic or Rangers strips, clothing, scarves or propaganda from students and coaches at ANY TIME PLEASE. I would expect similar professionalism from parents.
- Students must wear their Scotland Tracksuit for the journey down and arrive with this on. The kit does NOT have to be worn around the camp or at training sessions but MUST be worn to matches ...
- Full kit MUST be worn for the Presentation.
- For the first time, due to the volume of teams involved this year, games are going to be running onto the Monday lunch time with the Presentation following that. So it might be a loooooong weekend !!! Students can travel home in any clothing.
- We are planning to have a series of BARBEQUES for the students....so can all parents manage to pack one of these portable – throw away barbecues that you can pick up from Tesco's or Asda....they cost about five pounds !!!
- Can all parents throw into their freezer bag a 'barbecuable item' i.e some chops, steaks, sausages etc etcas I say stick them in your freezer bag....it saves us all eating out, as these camps cost a fortune. Barbeques go down well.

- Ultimately, although coaches are 'on duty' 24 hours a day (in my case 36 hours a day) ...YOU are responsible for your child's behaviour, discipline, health and safety and **whereabouts** **ALWAYS ASK WHERE THEY ARE GOING AND MAKE SURE THEY ACTUALLY GO AND STAY THERE AND THAT THEY LET YOU KNOW WHEN THEY ARE GOING SOMEWHERE ELSE.**
- Remember if there are any problems, questions and/or queries...ring my Mobile DAY or NIGHT – 07976083520.....does not matter what time you ring me.
- Ensure that the students go to bed at a reasonable hour especially if they have games early the next day. Don't allow them to say 'but the other teams get out late' explain to them that this is why other teams don't win trophies !! ...and you can blame me and say I told you they had to be in bed for a reasonable hour.
- Ensure they are dropped off and picked up on time from 'training'. There is no need for you to 'sit through' the training.
- Ensure they EAT properly and are constantly drinking fluids. Any issues with them not eating...refer them to 'the Headmaster' (they know who that is !!) and they know the consequences.
- Ultimately we will try to give each student equal lengths of 'football' but remember...the goal is to win the tournament !!
- Coaches should travel in their official tracksuit and remember they will be on duty from the moment they leave their house !! There will be a tournament coaches meeting on arrival on the Friday night....all will be expected to attend. There will be a Scotland Boys Club coaches meeting immediately AFTER the tournament coaches meeting to go over our itinerary and explain roles and responsibilities. ALL must attend.
- **AND DO REMEMBER THESE STUDENTS ARE ON HOLIDAY....**

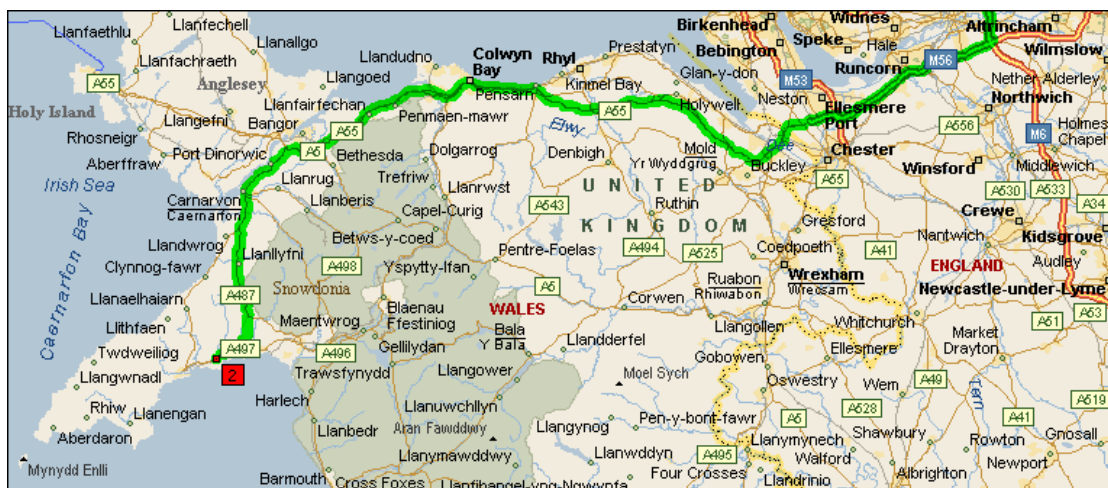

From the North & North West

At Chester, pick up the A55 and A5. Join A487 to Caernarfon, then A499 to Pwllheli. Then A497 to Porthmadog. The Park is on the right, approximately 3 miles out of Pwllheli.

The nearest train and bus station

The nearest train and bus station are in Pwllheli about 4 miles from Hafan y Môr.

Is it a nice place ? :

A friend (ex-Barnsley FC) I was talking to quotes :

'If you can picture a cemetery on a good day i.e. sun shining, a few people milling around looking miserable and perhaps the very distant sound of excited, childish screams from a local swimming pool, then you'll have a fairly accurate image of the Hafan Y Mor Holiday Park, North Wales in October.'

Pitch Information

All matches are played at Clwb Chwaraeon Madog, Porthmadog.

Directions

Turn Right out of Hafan-y-Mor and follow the road into Porthmadog (about 8 miles).

Turn right at the roundabout as you come into Porthmahog and then left into Snowdon Street.

Follow the road down about half a mile to Clwb Chwaraeon Madog.

Journey Time : Half a hour in December.

Remember hundreds o cars will be heading for the parks so I would leave at LEAST one hour before kick off time.

Make sure when students come to the games they are kitted out in full regalia.

There are fairly substantial breaks between games so they will need tracksuits, and Rain jackets. (Gloves and Tammies as it WILL be cold.)

Also have ample juice and snacks for them as there will be nowhere for them to buy any drinks or food.
