These students MUST START PAYING THEIR SUBSCRIPTIONS TO THERESA AS FROM THIS WEEK IF THEY WISH TO CONTINUE (I am aware some of you have been paying for quite a while now). Its £5 per week (two siblings or more its £7 per week total)

What you must now do:

- 1. Find out your squad number from Theresa (also will be published in next week's newsletter). You must get hold of the Scotland Home Strip. Now I am aware it is changing...but you must obtain it as soon as possible. You will find out that they are now in the shops CHEAPER because of the change. You can either go ONLINE www.scottishfa.co.uk ... and click onto the Scotland Collection...you should get it there. Then take it over to DEE SPORTS in DUNDYVAN ROAD, Coatbridge and he will number the strip and put your son's name on the back. The shorts must be numbered also.
 - Try 'Sports Soccer'; outlets (The Donnay Shops).
 - Try www.acasports.co.uk
 - Some of the bigger JJB Sports have them too.
 - Try lain Ferguson's shop at Parkhead Forge...he might be able to get them for you cheap.
 Once you have the strip we can start getting your youngster involved in 'bounce' games (interclub matches) ...then hopefully ...REAL games.
 - If anyone can give me the name of a stockist with kits in stock ...please tell me and I will put it
 in the Newsletter. Lots of parents are telling me they cannot get the current strip for love nor
 money.
- 2. You must NOT order a Tracksuit at the moment. We are potentially re-vamping the tracksuit situation and will keep you advised re-this situation. Once the tracksuits are available we will advise you and then you can organise those. The tracksuits must then get taken over to DEE SPORTS and he will embroider the tracksuit with your son/daughter's initials (on the top and the trousers) and he will screenprint 'Scotland Boys Club' on the back. This ensures NOTHING will get 'lost'.
- 3. You can go ahead and order the Black Rain-Jacket with the red stripe available online (Size 28 is smallest)so they are kept warm at training. **DEE SPORTS** will embroider your son/daughter's initials on the front for you. Therse are available online via the SFA Web Site click onto the 'Scotland Collection'.

- 4. New Training Kits will be available after Xmas for ALL students....watch this space....this will save wear and tear on the strips which will eventually be used for games only.
- 5. You can go ahead and order online a Tammy, and pick up a pair of good shinguards, a pair of **NAVY** 'magic' gloves, and get yourselves a Size 4 Ball to bring to training.
- 6. Boots must NOT have aluminium studs or aluminium tips. In fact I do not recommend anything else but 'moulded studs' at this age. Even plastic studs are banned....only rubber studs are permitted.
- 7. You must fill out an enrolment form and consent form (attached to this newsletter,) a photocopy of your son/daughter's birth certificate (shortened version will do), and 2 up to date passport photos with their official Scotland top on !!! These are all urgent now.
- 8. The **bags are changing also**.....so watch this space for further details of bags. I should know what is happening in a few weeks.

 being reduced to TEN PLAYERS as from NOW.
- When the 1999 Squad are playing, Alistair Whyte will contact those involved by the Tuesday night of the week in question. He will ONLY ring players who have been selected to participate. Squads are now being reduced to TEN PLAYERS as from NOW. We have got to remember that this group are playing one year out of their age group and results do not really matter they are only in this league for the experience.. It will have been noticed that we have included some full 1998 Academy players to keep the scores respectablebut this practice will slowly come to an end. They will over the next two months have to fight their own battles....but when they play in their own age Group come September...they should be unstoppable.
- Please support these youngsters and encourage them. For goodness sake some of them
