## Samples of new kit just about ready to go !!!

### Latest on kit !

**Can I just clarify the position in relation to KIT.** Dee Sports have been offered the first bulk purchasing contract for the Academy since our rift with the marketing section at the SFA. They have ordered in 'samples' of the new kit in a variety of sizes and our next job is to measure **EVERY** student, and then order the kits. The kit will comprise of.....

- **A New Training Kit (TShirt, Shorts and socks)**
- **A New Tracksuit (for games)**
- **A New Training Top (Waterproof) and the option to buy tracksuit trousers for it**
- **A Rain Jacket (training & games)**
- **A Large Main Holdall (Games)**
- **A 'training bag' – shoulder - simply for training purposes (for juice, boots etc)**
- **Scotland Tammies – saying 'Scotland Boys Club' on it.**
- **Gloves – navy.**

THE ENTIRE KIT WILL BE **BADGED, NUMBERED AND EMBROIDERED** WITH EITHER YOUR CHILDS INITIALS OR SQUAD NUMBER – EVERY ARTICLE WILL BE LABELLED ONE WAY OR ANOTHER... INCLUDING BAGS. No more 'lost' trackie tops....WE HAVE NOT GOT AN EXACT PRICE FOR THIS AS YET BUT WE ARE TRYING TO DO EVERYTHING FOR ROUGHLY AROUND **£130** in total including all numbering and embroidering.....**and you will not beat that price anywhere.**

The good thing is that this is quality material (checked by two parents) and should wash well and wear well.

The kit may be a little big for the 2000 age group ...but you will need to purchase the smallest size anyway and they **WILL** very quickly grow into it. I am fed up with everyone coming to training like liquorice allsorts...all different. This is going to be our kit for a number of years ...so we have to get it right.

The measuring team will be round you all in the next couple of weeks with a target date of Xmas 2006 for **EVERYONE** to be kitted out in for the start of 2007. It is also imperative that the Coaches get measured up too...and as I have already said, they will have to purchase their own kit as above. . We cannot subsidise 20 coaches kits at £130 per kit.

The kits will obviously be priced individually so that, for example, the 1998 Academy PLUS or School of Excellence parents may not want to buy a bag (as they have two already) but may want to buy the rest of the kit !! To buy everything individually will be **MUCH more expensive** as you would not qualify for the extensive discount you would be given if you buy the full package.
