HOW THE NEW TOTE WORKS



Introduction of the TOTE System (to replace the FOUR BALL Lottery).

What is it for ?

The new TOTE system is a unique fund raising venture designed to raise FUNDS to finance holidays. With the invitation to Cork imminent, and the amount of interest it has generated, people are desperate to go ...but NOT at the costs quoted. This fund (which will be kept separate from normal funds) is the ideal opportunity to lesson the costs of this and other trips. If it is successful, it could also be used to fund the proposed Canada trip in 2009. The idea has been thought up by Michael Innes and it needs the support and backing of YOU ...the parents.

Setting Up

This weekend, at the Land O Burns Festival in Ayr, Michael Innes will be looking for a volunteer (parent) from each age group to approach him and volunteer their services to assist in the collection of these sheets. If we can have one volunteer from 1998's, 1999's, and 2000's this will make life much easier as there is a lot of work involved in this type of tote. Provided we can have these volunteers in place by Sunday night, it is our intention to issue the tote sheet this weekend so it can start the following weekend. It will be issued by email on a Sunday night. For those who are NOT on email – we are going to have to make some sort of arrangement to get the sheets either posted or handed in to you but we can talk about that nearer the time.

How does it work ?

As you can see from the attached sheet, Michael will choose six games every weekend. When you get the sheets out, look at the games and decide whether they are going to be home wins, away wins or indeed draws. Fill out a 'line' (see sheet) ...and hand in your 50p ...its as simple as that.

But clearly we would not make any money if everyone only chose ONE LINE...so the opportunity is there for you to 'sell' the other lines. In a standard family the student would take a couple of lines and so would the Mum and Dad. It is not essential to fill ALL the lines...but it would be terrific if you could fill as many as possible.

As the prize money grows (and it will grow fairly rapidly if it does not get won) ...watch how many more people offer to buy 'lines'. If you work in a big factory you may need to print off two or more sheets. You can print off as many sheets as you like. The more the merrier.

Can everyone please read the personalised letter (below) which I intended sending as an email as mentioned in the Newsletter of a couple of weeks ago. I have decided that it would be better if we publicised it to show our commitment to the cause

Dear Parents

I mentioned two weeks ago, in the Newsletter, that I would be sending everyone an email regarding certain complaints that have been made towards your Academy. Instead I have decided to publicise our thoughts.

When I submitted our registrations in the Summer, as usual to the appropriate Leagues, one particular organisation decided to reject our applications. When I queried this, I was told to attend a Disciplinary Meeting to answer a case of '**not following soccer sevens philosophy**'.

When I answered the case and asked for a defined description of what we had done wrong, a number of points were raised, many of which were my fault, some which were not. The points in question were :

- (1) Not playing evenly matched teams – having a strong team and a weak team
- (2) Commenting on other teams in our Newsletter (some comments were derogatory)
- (3) Putting 'scores' in our Newsletter
- (4) Parents being aggressive towards other coaches / officials
- (5) Parents coaching from the side of the park.
- (6) Officials having an aggressive manner.
- (7) Using names to distinguish squads ie School of Excellence

For those reasons and other minor reasons they decided to reject our applications. I am very aware of the clubs concerned who made the allegations but will not be naming them for legal reasons. However there are certain issues that we must address as an Academy.

Fortunately for all concerned, we appealed against the decision and the 'ban' has now been lifted for a trial period for the first part of the season...this will now allow 60 children the right to play soccer sevens again. There have been a number of recommendations made to us as an Academy in terms of what we put and what we do not put in Newsletters...and I can control that ...but I cannot control the actions of officials and parents. I can only ask very nicely to please think before you react because the Executive Committee of this particular league made it loud and clear that this sort of behaviour will not be tolerated.

Please watch where your copy of the Newsletter goes. I was confronted with copies of my own Newsletters as far back as six months ago with certain areas highlighted. People are phoning me (people I don't even know) and asking what happened to 'their' newsletter this week...even from senior clubs !!!!Now that is a fact.

In terms of discipline and behaviour, and coaching from the side ...parents please leave it up to us. Coaches, I know you are all dedicated to the cause and are fully enthusiastic about winning, and I know you are passionate towards the club...but please take a deep breath before reacting. In terms of my personal input, the forthcoming web site and future Newsletters will not name other teams except to say who we are playing, will not give results, and will not say anything derogatory about any other club or organisation. Also all the names 'School of Excellence etc' are being replaced by colours.

The only age group who suffer from 'a stronger team and a weaker team' is the 1999 age group and we will counteract that problem by placing TWO players from the 'Navy' team into the 'White' team, every week. These players will rotate on a weekly basis. I have detailed these changes to the League executive committee and they seem happy with that. They will of course send representatives from the league along to check, and other teams that we play will report back to the committee. This has been agreed by Scotland Boys Club in writing and I trust coaches will adhere to this ruling. If parents are unhappy about this then I apologise but we have no alternative but to inflict such a policy – otherwise we will freeze the entire Academy out of regular football.

I can only ask for all your co-operation in these points, its perhaps just a fact that the Academy has become 'too good for its own success' – who knows. Saying that, we have more youngsters training with senior clubs now than the entire league put together, so we must be doing something right.

Let's all have a fabulous season and prove to everyone that we do 'follow the philosophy of soccer sevens'.

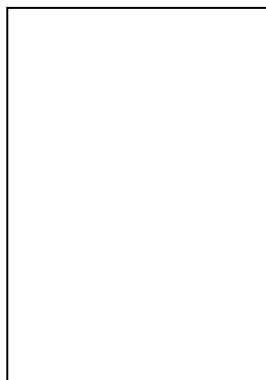
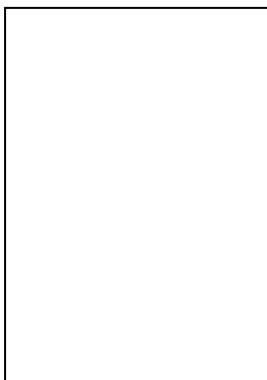
