## TOTE STARTS NEXT WEEKEND



### Introduction of the TOTE System (to replace the FOUR BALL Lottery).

#### Many thanks to our volunteers

Michael Innes asked for volunteers to assist in the running of the TOTE SYSTEM and we are delighted to announce that he got his FOUR volunteers. They are Theresa (Treasurer), Jackie Glasgow 1999's, Elizabeth Stewart 2000 / 2001's, and Kate Black 1998's. Can I take this opportunity of thanking them for their services.

#### Setting Up

Michael has went to a lot of trouble to set-up the system to start NEXT weekend and will, from now on publish the 'weekly entry team sheet' in the Newsletter. For those who CANNOT print this off before training, paper copies will be available from the parties named above at training and at games at the weekend (every week). The completed sheets MUST be handed in BEFORE 3.00 pm (kick off time) on the Saturday afternoon. Theresa O Hara will be responsible for collecting and banking all the said monies collected and this money will be kept in a SEPARATE ACCOUNT named 'Holiday Fund'.

The total value of this fund will be announced on the Newsletter or subsequently – web site – every month. Michael Innes will be responsible for checking the 'winning numbers' and Theresa responsible for paying out prize money. This money will NOT BE USED for anything else except holidays. We would expect that all seventy parents would sell at least TEN lines totalling £5 minimum. Hopefully you will all sell more (especially as the fund 'grows' !!! ) Print out more sheets as you need them.

#### How does it work ?

As you can see from the attached sheet, Michael has chosen six games. When you get the sheets out, look at the games and decide whether they are going to be home wins, away wins or indeed draws. Fill out a 'line' (see sheet) ...and hand in your 50p ...its as simple as that.

But as I say – hopefully everyone will buy five pounds worth minimum to see how it goes. Clearly we would not make any money if everyone only chose ONE LINE...so the opportunity is there for you to 'sell' the other lines. In a standard family the student would take a couple of lines and so would the Mum and Dad. It is not essential to fill ALL the lines...but it would be terrific if you could fill as many as possible.

As the prize money grows (and it will grow fairly rapidly if it does not get won) ...watch how many more people offer to buy 'lines'. If you work in a big factory you may need to print off two or more sheets.

You can print off as many sheets as you like. The more the merrier.
