## **Balls**

Several students did not bring footballs to training last Friday and it caused operational problems. I am very aware that 'balls' are indeed going missing.....so please bring a cheap ball....JJB do a £1.99 Umbro or Patrick ball which should suffice. **Please put your name on your ball** with a permanent marker. Parents – check to see that your son has picked up the correct ball and if it has someone else's name on it – please return it. **The practice of bringing their own footballs to training is going to diminish SHORTLY.** I am going to place an order for footballs over the next two weeks so that from October onwards, the coaches will be given 10 balls for training (one for each player) and players will no longer be required to bring footballs to training. **Each coach will be responsible for their own ten footballs – when one is 'wrecked' they simply contact me and I will replace it. I will also be supplying each coach with a set of bibs, an equipment bag, a ropeladder, and a set of cones. Coaches will from 1<sup>st</sup> October will be responsible for their own equipment. ## **1999's**

Last week in the Newsletter, I clearly indicated who would be playing in what squads to ensure the 'rota' system was in operation. Now this did not happen for whatever reason. Again this week, I will indicate who will play in what squad and the two coaches **MUST ensure this happens** to the letter. I will start with exactly the same rota that I intended to use last week. These are the squads that I email to the league on a Friday night and **MUST be adhered to.** Only I can authorise a change to these squads. It is the coaches responsibility to check who is playing in their squads and ensure this happens. If it does not happen I will have no alternative but to re-allocate the groups. **Please check on a Friday night, WHEN YOU GET YOUR NEWSLETTER.**

## Still struggling

We are still struggling with player squads. I had intended advertising last week but never had the time to sit down and get it finished due to my Dublin trip.....hopefully I will get it sorted for the next couple of weeks. Again, there is a mix and match happening this weekend. My main objective is to try and ensure that every child gets some football this weekend so apologies for the mish mash...it will stabilise over the next two or three weeks. Again, if anyone is unhappy with the squads their sons are in (if not their own squad)...please give me a ring and I will adjust.

## Equal Playing Time

Coaches must try and ensure **EQUAL PLAYING TIME** for all students. (as near as you can)...we are not talking about someone getting five or ten minutes more than someone else.....There is no exceptions or exemptions to this rule. There are **TEN PLAYERS** in each squad, so it is very easy to organise on a half time rota basis or whatever. If (and this can happen) a coach is left with **11 players** then playing time will be a little less. Try and ensure that everyone gets at least **30 minutes** (if you can) throughout the course of the day. These arrangements might be different in the West Lothian League where there is only one game and playing times differ. Try and make it **FAIR** please guys.

## Interesting little expense

Funny old world isn't it. The West Lothian League insist on official referees at £16 per week, for non-competitive football ?? They have league tables, they record scores, they record goals and have a league table set-up which shows first, second, third etc...and shows goals for and against.....whatever next ...League Winners medals ??? .....it is a sharp contrast to what we are used to. How rules differ !!!

## Not turning up to training

Quite a few players are not turning up to training, but more importantly, their parents are not even bothering to phone. This is totally unacceptable and shows a total lack of respect. If your son is unwell on the Friday – then he is unwell for the Saturday morning. He will not play. If there is another reason for him being absent **...PLEASE HAVE THE DECENCY TO TELEPHONE**. If you cannot phone the coach of the team...**THEN PHONE ME. !!!** .....No excuse. If you do not phone ....your son will not play on the Saturday morning.

## Bag Packs

The Academy have been asked to do bag packs in several supermarkets around December time. Before I accept these bag packs I need to be assured of **'people to pack the bags'**. Not just Mums ....Dads, Gran's, Brothers and Sisters....pals even. Essentially what happens is that after the Saturday morning game, the students (dressed in their tracksuits) and their parents head for the supermarket in question and basically get 'tore in'. If your game was an early kick off ...you head straight over with your bucket....the parent does the packing and the child does the smiling. When the late kick off brigade turn up, you can all relieve each other so that the tills are manned all day....and every 'pair' get a little rest. Why not ask your local supermarket if they can accommodate us. Please ask.....we need to collect every penny for these holidays. **I NEED YOU TO GIVE YOUR NAME TO THERESA AS SOON AS POSSIBLE SO I CAN MAKE UP ROTAS TO FIT IN WITH THE FIXTURES. It is absolutely necessary because of our hostile relationship with a lot of clubs due to the issues raised in the close season. Also report to me incidents re- teams playing 'strong' and 'weak' teams....so that we can report this and monitor this.

Can coaches pick up from me this Friday night the league '**MONITORING SHEET**' which I will explain to you before you go to your games at the weekend. **PLEASE DO NOT FORGET....and do not forget your team sheets. !!!! Pick them up from Theresa or myself.**
