## **SFA Initiative**

**The SFA** are encouraging more pro-active coaching sessions for children and to promote this initiative, Bobby Mc Donald will be running a series of 'free' development sessions under this banner. Based on the four key principles of the game, ie Width, Penetration, Depth, and Support. These sessions are designed for groups of eight players + two goalkeepers and will be held in the **indoor arena at Hamilton Palace** (dates to be announced). The goalkeepers in these sessions will be 'runners' to make sessions practical...and will not be coached. We will also be running one of these sessions especially for goalkeepers where they will be coached. Coaches will also be invited to these sessions where they can take notes and develop their own skills to take back to their training sessions. Sessions will last one hour. Any parent's who wish to 'book' their son/daughter onto these sessions which begin in October should give their names to Theresa **NOW** and places will be allocated on a first come first served basis. Remember these are **coaching sessions – NOT Training Sessions**....concentration and listening skills are needed more so than natural ability.

**A typical session will involve :**

- (1) Introduction – Chalk and Talk – 5 mins
- (2) Warm Up – 10 mins
- (3) Bedding down of key coaching points – 'listen in exercise' - 15 mins
- (4) Game Related practice (relating to theme) – 15 mins
- (5) Conditioned game (related to theme) – 10 minutes
- (6) Cool down - 5 mins

The first session will be on **DEPTH ..... NAMES TO THERESA NOW PLEASE (INCLUDING COACHES).....**
