Last Weekend

Another terrific weekend with every team winning all their games. **ALL the 1998 teams**, Navy, White and Yellow, won every single game (including the **RED** squad who had two brilliant victories at Nethercraigs). The **1999 Squads** (both squads) had **four** victories also and the **TWO 2000** squads had four fantastic victories too.

Bribery and/or Coaching

Over three years ago now, we had a very serious problem with parents. They were visibly seen, by other parents, by scouts and by opposing teams openly **BRIBING** their sons by offering money for them to score goals. This was totally unacceptable and caused youngsters not to listen to coaches (but to their parents), greedy children, children not passing the ball, children not keeping to their positions, the entire squad not playing as a team etc etc. We raised the riot act, and laid down the law as it stands. The result, as you can see, is the production of one of the finest footballing academies in the **UK** at this age group.

Unfortunately, this trend has reared its ugly head again. We are now seeing this situation happening with the current 2000 squad and this has been reported back to us by 'outsiders'. Another thing which is happening is that parents are once again **COACHING** from the side of the park. **WE WILL NOT TOLERATE THIS TYPE OF IRRESPONSIBLE BEHAVIOUR**. Already scouts are contacting us regarding your youngsters and for this reason alone we must promote a professional attitude and example.

So we are making it very clear in this Newsletter, if you want to **OFFER BRIBES**, please take your son to some other club....because we will not tolerate it in the Academy. If he is not going to listen to coaching instruction....we will have the same take on the matter. Scotland Boys Club is the biggest 'shop window' you can hope for at this age group....dinna spoil things and leave the professional coaching to us. Several sets of parents fell foul last weekend. It is also breaking the **Lanarkshire Youth Football Association – Parents Code of Conduct** – which this Club signed up to....and we could be 'kicked out' the League because of such an event.

Team Sheets

I have had the second complaint of the season re-Team Sheets this time. **The 1999 team sheets** were not exchanged last week which is causing me all sorts of heartache from the League Secretary **AND** the opposing team secretary.. It is a simple question of printing them off at some point in the week (you all have the masters) and giving a copy to the opposition. **Can all coaches** please ensure that they do this on a regular weekly basis. When the opposition give you their copy, save them up and give to me at the end of every month. If the opposition **DO NOT GIVE** you team sheets – you still give them their copy and ensure you **REPORT** this to me that weekend so I can in turn report them. **Thank you for your co-operation in this matter.**
