2000 Age Group Misunderstanding

Some parents have misunderstood the changes that have been made in this age group. If I can quickly explain. I have taken over this age group during the month of November to work with Jim Ruddick as his mentor to show him how to shape a seven a side team. To assist me in this role I have enlisted some of the AFC development squad. This temporary arrangement will have another benefit in the fact that the players we have 'moved' into John's squad will get an opportunity to play alongside stronger players and who knows ...might surprise themselves. For the week 1st December 2007....the said players will go back into their original squads. Unless....and there is a very big unless....if any of the players who moved into John's squad did exceptionally well so that they justified a place in that squad.....they could be asked to remain in that squad.....on the other hand ...if someone who moved to Jim's squad deteriorated ever so slightly...they could be asked to remain in that squad. Those 'decisions' would be John Renwick's decisions and his decisions alone...This is not a new thing...it is something we have been doing successfully for years. It keeps the students 'on their toes'.

Hamilton Palace – indoor facility

I have noticed that when the Academy are using the 'indoor facility' a lot of 'strangers' are playing of the surface whilst the teams are training. Now this is absolutely forbidden due to insurance and health & safety purposes. Can coaches please ensure that brothers, sisters, parents and Auntie Mary's are kept **BEHIND** the fence at all times. This is happening at **EVERY age group**, both Fridays and Sundays and also happens at the AFC training sessions. **It has to stop.....PLEASE** !!!

Equipment for New Players and Coaches

I THINK I AM CORRECT IN SAYING THAT MOST (EXCEPT ONE I BELIEVE) of the coaches have now managed to order and start paying for Tracksuits. This is absolutely fabulous....but we need to get everyone up to scratch as soon as possible. There are also quite a few **NEW PLAYERS** now – who have not ordered the kits. All new players must liase with Theresa, get a squad number as soon as possible, start paying their subs on a monthly basis from **NOW**, and order and pay for the Tracksuit and additional accessories. They must also of course organise their Scotland Home Strip and get their squad number put on at **DEE SPORTS** before they can play matches. This is particularly apparent of the new group **2000/2001's** which Robert Sands is organising. I cannot arrange games for this group until they are all fully kitted outso please see Theresa as soon as possible.

Last Weekend

The 1998's (Navy, and White) squads had really tough end to end matches at the weekend, winning two, drawing one and losing one. The Yellow squad won 13-nil'ish......and the 2000 age group had another four wins. The 1999's had slightly more difficult games but again managed three wins and one draw. The 'red' 1998 squad again struggled at Nethercraigs losing both matches.

It is becoming increasingly apparent that these 'easy' games are benefitting no-one. The students think they are world beaters, the opposition are demorolised, the parents are bored....and no one is learning anything. To try and counteract this imbalance, John Renwick and I have decided to slightly go 'against the grain' and re-think club policy regarding students playing out their age group. There has been a proposition put on the table to debate the following changes after Xmas.

The **2000 'Navy' team** will join the 1999 'White' team and those will be the two 1999 teams after Xmas.

The 1999 'Navy' team will join a single team 1998 league.

The **new 2000/2001 squad** will become the other 2000 team and them plus the 2000 'white' will be the two 2000 squads.

The 1998 'yellow' squad will join a 1997 one team league.

Now these are <u>only thoughts</u> at the moment, all subject to the coaching staff agreeing, no major objections from parents, and of course us being able to **FIND** leagues that will 'adopt' us mid season !!! It would be a major change of policy ...but it would only be for half a season to see if it works. **Watch this space** !!!
