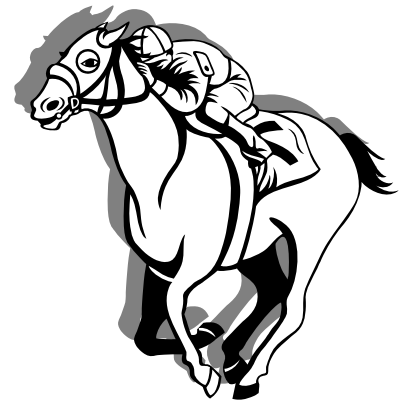

## RAFFLE DRAW.
